RECEIPT OF PROPOSALS

Sealed proposals for the construction of the City of Muldraugh, Kentucky Highway 31W / Old Main Street Water Main Replacement and Snyder Way Water Main Replacement shall be received at the office of the City Hall of Muldraugh Kentucky, 202 Wendell Street, Muldraugh, Kentucky 40155, on or before 10:00 a.m. Eastern Local time (9:00 CST) on Wednesday, May 6, 2026 and immediately thereafter all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The project will include the following described construction:

The Base Bid project – Highway 31W / Old Main Street Water Main Replacement will include the following described construction:

The furnishing, installing, and testing of approximately 2,575 linear feet of 12" C900 PVC and Ductile Iron water mains; including all valves, fittings, reconnections of proposed PVC water mains to existing water mains, fire hydrant replacements and removals, service taps on new water mains and service reconnections prior to meter, service tubing, detection tape and trace wire, unclassified excavation, bedding, backfill, tie-ins and maintaining water main service, restoration, pavement restoration, testing, and all other work as shown on the Construction Drawings or indicated in the Contract Specifications.

The Additive Alternate project – Snyder Way Water Main Replacement (if authorized by the Owner) will include the following described construction:

The furnishing, installing, and testing of approximately 810 linear feet of 8" C900 PVC water mains; including all valves, fittings, reconnections of proposed PVC water mains to existing water mains, fire hydrant replacements and removals, service taps on new water mains and service reconnections prior to meter, service tubing, detection tape and trace wire, unclassified excavation, bedding, backfill, tie-ins and maintaining water main service, restoration, pavement restoration, testing, and all other work as shown on the Construction Drawings or indicated in the Contract Specifications.

Official (numbered) Bid Documents shall be obtained at the office of Water Management Services, LLC, 2 International Plaza, Suite 401, Nashville, Tennessee 37217 (telephone: (615-366-6088). A nonrefundable fee of \$100.00 must be made for each set obtained.

The successful bidder shall be required to fully complete all work within **150** consecutive calendar days from and including the date to start work established in a written order from the City of Muldraugh, Kentucky. If the Additive Alternate portion of the project is authorized by the Owner, then the successful bidder shall be required to fully complete all work for the Base Bid and Additive Alternate within **150** consecutive calendar days from and including the date to start work established in a written order from the City of Muldraugh.

City of Muldraugh, Kentucky reserves the right to reject any proposal for failure to comply with all requirements of the notice or of any of the Contract Documents; however, it may waive any minor defects or informalities at its discretion. City of Muldraugh, Kentucky further reserves the right to reject all proposals.
