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- I. **Scope:** The Lincoln Trail Area Development District is seeking a qualified and experienced provider (hereafter referred to as company, contractor or bidder) to provide:

  - b. **All work shall be completed to the specifications pursuant to direction and supervision of LTADD's engineer.**

- III. **RFP Submission:** All RFP submissions must include all items listed on the attached document of the RFP, as described herein. Proposals will be accepted at the LTADD Offices, 750 South Provident Way, Elizabethtown, KY until: **FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2026 AT 10:00 AM EST**. Proposals must be submitted in sealed envelopes with the words **PROPOSAL FOR: LTADD CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS, FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2026 AT 10:00 AM EST**, prominently displayed on the front of the envelope. Respondents shall include one (1) original and six (6) copies of the entire RFP response.
- IV. **Addendums to RFP:** In the event it becomes necessary to revise any part of the RFP specifications, any potential bidder who requested the RFP specifications will be provided any and all addendums to the RFP information.
- V. **Late Submittal and Late Modifications:** Submittals received after the due date and time will not be considered. Modifications received after the opening date will not be considered. LTADD assumes no responsibility for the premature opening of a proposal not properly addressed and identified, and/or delivered to an improper designation.
- VI. **Rejection or Cancellation of Proposals:** LTADD reserves the right to act in its best interest in this determinations process, to waive all technicalities, and to select the most responsible and responsive proposal. LTADD shall be the sole judge of the company's ability to meet the requirements set forth. Its decision in determining responsible and responsive bidder(s) will be final.
- VII. **Minimum Acceptance Period:** Proposals shall be valid and may not be withdrawn for a period of 180 days from the date specified for receipt of proposals. All expenses involved with the preparation and submission of the proposal to LTADD, or any work performed in connection therewith, is the responsibility of the bidder(s).
- VIII. **Confidential and Proprietary Information:** Per KRS 61.878 (1)(c), to the extent that a proposal includes proprietary and confidential information, bidder shall mark the information as such and is assured that LTADD, in compliance with KRS Chapter 61, shall maintain the confidentiality of such information and exempt such from open or public



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disclosure until such time as a contract is awarded and then shall release it only to the extent required by the KY Open Records and Open Meetings Acts.

- X. **Termination:** As agreed to in the final, written contract, LTADD may terminate the contract with the winning bidder at any time if, after notice and reasonable opportunity to cure any such default, the financial institution continues to fail to provide the required services by providing ninety (90) days advance written notice to the designated representative of the company.
- XI. **Designated Contact:** The contractor shall appoint a person or persons to act as a primary contact with LTADD. This person or back-up shall be readily available during business hours by phone or in person, and shall be knowledgeable of the terms and procedures involved.
- XII. **Open Records Act:** All materials submitted in connection with this proposal will be public documents and subject to the Open Records Act and all other laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, the United States of America and the open records policies of LTADD. All such materials shall remain the property of LTADD and will not be returned to the respondent.
- XIII. **Performance Standards:** The work shall be completed to the specifications pursuant to direction and supervision of LTADD's engineer.

**CORRUGATED PIPE, PRE-ENGINEERED  
CULVERTS, STEEL BRIDGES, GUARDRAIL AND  
EROSION CONTROL PRODUCTS**

**I. GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- A. The purpose of this invitation is to receive firm bid prices from which the Community Asset Planning & Engineering Division of the Lincoln Trail Area Development District (hereinafter LTADD) can award price contract(s) for corrugated, aluminized and plastic pipe, pre-engineering culverts, steel bridge packages, bridge rehabilitation packages, guardrail and erosion control materials to successful bidder(s) for furnishing any part of the bid specifications during the Contract period of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027.
- B. The bid prices shall be effective for all LTADD member units of government, which are Breckinridge, Grayson, Hardin, Larue, Marion, Meade, Nelson and Washington Counties and the incorporated cities therein.
- C. Pursuant to KRS 45A.455, the LTADD will not participate or have an interest in the selection or in the award of any procurement transaction if a conflict of interest exists.
- D. All prices bid herein will be firm against any increase for the Contract period. All prices bid shall not be considered unless the bid is firm during the Contract period.
- E. A written acceptance of the offer will be mailed to the successful bidder(s) within 30 days of the bid opening.
- F. The LTADD member unit of governments are responsible for selecting and contracting with approved bidders, based upon the best-evaluated bid for that unit of government.
- G. The member units of government are exempt from Kentucky State Sales tax.
- H. The vendor shall be paid, upon the submission of proper invoices, to the receiving member unit of government at the prices stipulated for supplies delivered or accepted, or services rendered.
- I. The LTADD reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids for any or no reason.

**II. PRICING**

- A. Bidders must determine their single best price based on the specifications. The unit bid price quoted must be bid:
  - 1. On the basis of FOB to the designated Point of Delivery, all freight prepared in truckload lots.

2. Best bid price per item based upon the vendor loading the materials onto the LTADD member unit of government trucks at your point of manufacture or storage facility.

B. See attached list of items to be included in the bid.

### **III. SPECIFICATIONS**

A. All products must meet the current edition of the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Standard Specifications.

### **IV. DELIVERY**

#### **A. Freight on Board**

1. The delivery of products shall be to the location specified by the LTADD member unit of government on each delivery order, with all freight prepared in truckload lots. The responsibility for filing freight claims lies with the vendor.
2. Deliveries shall be made to the specified delivery location within ten (10) working days once a LTADD member unit of government places an order. When delivery is not made as provided in this contract, the LTADD member unit of government reserves the right to make the purchase on the open market.
3. All supplies and equipment shall be subject to inspection or test by LTADD member units of government prior to acceptance. In the event supplies or equipment are defective in material or workmanship, the LTADD member unit of government shall have the right to reject them or require acceptable correction at the vendor's expense.

### **V. METHOD OF AWARD**

Award will be made based on the best-evaluated bid per linear foot, including cost of transportation, for each item bid.

**BID ITEMS**

- A. **Corrugated Metal Pipe.** Provide pricing for all corrugations and gauge thickness available. Provide pricing for all material types available, including but not limited to spiral galvanized, aluminized type II, polymer-coated pipe, and aluminum pipe. Price both round and arched pipe. Also, quote unit prices for all shapes and sizes of structural plate pipe and pipe arches available in both steel and aluminum. Provide prices for all end sections and connecting bands available.
- B. **Aluminum Box Culverts.** Provide unit pricing for all sizes and accessories available, including but not limited to shell, invert, headwalls, wingwalls, corner panels, toe walls, receiving channel, and footing pads. Price structures for KYHL93, HS25, and HS20 load ratings. Bidder must provide signed and sealed fabrication, plate layout, and design calculations by manufacturer for any structure ordered by Owner. Bidder must have a Kentucky Registered Professional Engineer (PE) on staff to assist Owner in design and sizing of these type structures if required, and must be able to attend a mandatory onsite preconstruction meeting with Owner and provide an onsite inspection during construction by an employee of the culvert manufacturer if required.
- C. **Precast Concrete Arch Structures and Boxes.** Provide unit pricing for all sizes and accessories available, including but not limited to shell, invert, headwalls, wingwalls, and foundations. Price structures for KYHL93, HS25, and HS20 load ratings. Bidder must provide signed and sealed fabrication, layout, and design calculations by manufacturer for any structure ordered by Owner. Bidder must have a Kentucky Registered Professional Engineer (PE) on staff to assist Owner in design and sizing of these type structures if required, and must be able to attend a mandatory onsite preconstruction meeting with Owner and provide an onsite inspection during construction by an employee of the culvert manufacturer if required.
- D. **All Steel Bridge Packages Including Beam Span and Truss Structures.** Provide unit pricing for all sizes and accessories available. Price structures for KYHL93, HS25, and HS20 load ratings. Bidder must provide signed and sealed fabrication, layout, and design calculations by manufacturer for any structure

ordered by Owner. Bidder must have a Kentucky Registered Professional Engineer (PE) on staff to assist Owner in design and sizing of these type structures if required, and must be able to attend a mandatory onsite preconstruction meeting with Owner and provide an onsite inspection during construction by an employee of the bridge manufacturer if required.

- E. **Bridge Decking Products.** Provide unit pricing for Structural Plate Bridge Flooring, corrugations 2" to 6" and 3" to 9" in all gauges available. Price both punched and un-punched material.
- F. **Galvanized Steel Guardrail.** Provide prices for all guardrail materials available, including but not limited to Wand Thrie beam face, posts, blocking, and end treatments.
- G. **High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) Culvert Pipe.** Provide pricing for all sizes and lengths available. All pipes must have a smooth interior. Bidder may also provide unit pricing for Steel Reinforced Polyethylene (SRPE) Pipe for this bid if available.
- H. **Culvert Liner Products.** Provide prices for any culvert liner and/or rehabilitation products available. A minimum of HDPE Solid Wall SDR32.5 M/F Snap-lite liner pipe must be provided if bidding on this item. Provide prices for both round and Oval/Strutted sizes 10" thru 63" diameter. Bid should also include total installation with grouting annular space 100% as an option. Other materials such as PVC pipe and metal plate liner products may be quoted. Bidder must have a Kentucky Registered Professional Engineer (PE) on staff to assist Owner in design and sizing of these type structures if required, and must be able to attend a mandatory onsite preconstruction meeting with Owner and provide an onsite inspection during construction by an employee of the culvert manufacturer if required.
- I. **Slope Stabilization and Erosion Control and Stormwater Products.** Provide pricing for all products available including but not limited to geotextiles, geogrids, silt fences, gabions, armorflex, A-jacks, binwalls, and stormwater treatment, detention, infiltration, biofiltration and other LID solutions. Bidder must have a Kentucky Registered Professional Engineer (PE) on staff to assist Owner in design and sizing of these type structures if required, and must be

able to attend a mandatory onsite preconstruction meeting with Owner and provide an onsite inspection during construction by an employee of the culvert manufacturer if required.

## **NOTES**

Successful Bidder(s) must have a representative available to assist Owner in sizing and installation of structures and rehab materials for all items. Bidder must provide a professional engineer (PE) on products as noted.

Items A thru I shall be considered as a unit, with bid to be complete for all items and material to be delivered and unloaded as specified by the Owner.

Quote net prices only, no price escalation clauses

The delivery time and availability of material are to be listed and considered as part of the bid.

All materials must meet all federal and state highway specifications with a design load capacity to meet AASHTO guidelines. Manufacturer's material certification sheets must accompany bid where appropriate.

All materials must be manufactured and fabricated in the United States of America. Owner reserves the right to accept and or reject any and all bids.

## **HOURLY RATES FOR EQUIPMENT AND LABOR**

The Owner is requesting unit price bids from qualified contractors for hourly rates for equipment rental and labor for two Categories of Work: I) Small Culvert Replacements II) Large Culvert and Bridge Replacements/Rehabilitation

Bid proposals shall be filled out completely on the proposal forms provided to bidders contained herein.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids; reserves the right to waive any irregularities in the bidding procedure; to award to the lowest and best bidder, and to reject any and all bids that are obviously irregular.

### **I. Category of Work Description: I) Small Culvert Replacements**

This category of work includes repair and/or installation of small culverts (48" diameter or less) and incidental work that is required. Incidental work includes but is not limited to: sawcut existing road, demolish and/or remove existing drainage structure, unload and install County-provided replacement structure at jobsite, backfill structure with County-provided aggregate, add or replace guardrail, perform required earthwork and slope stability, and provide erosion control in compliance with County standards. Experience and necessary equipment will be a major factor in bid selection. Contractor shall own the equipment being bid upon. Contractor shall complete the work using no less than 80% of their own forces, except when subcontractors are approved by the County.

### **II. Category of Work Description: 2) Large Culvert and Bridge Replacements/Rehabilitation**

This category of work includes repair and/or installation of large culverts (54" diameter or greater) including small bridges and incidental work that is required. Incidental work includes but is not limited to: sawcut existing road, demolish and/or remove existing drainage structure, unload and install County-provided replacement structure at jobsite, backfill structure with County-provided aggregate, add or replace guardrail, perform required earthwork and slope stability, perform concrete work as required by the County, and provide erosion control in compliance with local and/or KYTC standards. Experience and necessary equipment will be a major factor in bid selection. Contractor shall own the equipment being bid upon. Contractor shall complete the work using no less than 80% of their own forces, except when subcontractors are approved by the County.

### **III. Time for Completion**

The County shall request in writing the ability of the accepted bidder to begin and complete a project within a particular schedule. The bidder shall confirm or not confirm, in writing, their ability to complete the project in the time allowed. If the Contractor is unable to perform the required work in a prescribed schedule because of other obligations or manpower, the County shall have the right to go to the second bidder for the work to complete the project.

### **IV. Insurance**

A certificate of liability insurance and a certificate of Workers Compensation insurance is required. Prior to beginning work, a certificate of insurance showing the Lincoln Trail ADD and the member unit of government in which the work is being performed as an additional insured on the liability policy with a minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 shall be furnished to the Owner. This additional insurance pertains only to work performed for the Owner by the Contractor.

### **VI. Bid Award**

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive any informality or irregularity in a bid. The Owner reserves the right to allow a Bidder up to 5 calendar days to furnish or correct documentation in the event the Owner discovers an omission or error in the bid received. The Owner reserves the right to accept the bid that provides the best value to the Owner at the Owner's sole discretion.
